

What makes Santa Barbara's Lobero Theatre a favorite venue of stars like actor/musician Jeff Bridges? Its comfortable, community atmosphere.

The Lobero is California's oldest continuously operating theatre. Originally founded in 1873 and rebuilt in 1924 with plans by the famed George Washington Smith and Lutah Maria Riggs, it is recognized as one of Santa Barbara's architectural jewels and a State and City landmark.

The Lobero Theatre has been the heart and rhythm of Santa Barbara for 150 Years.

The Lobero's exterior Esplanade was built in 2013 using the original 1922 plans, and recent

renovations such as new seats, expanded restrooms, and other upgrades bring modern-day comfort.

Since opening, each era's greatest talents have graced our stage. The glittering 1920's brought Hollywood "preview performances" with the likes of Bela Lugosi, Lionel Barrymore, and Sergei Rachmaninoff. The 1940's saw Clark Gable, Ingrid Bergman, Igor Stravinsky and dozens more. Our tradition of hosting the "Who's Who" of the jazz world began in 1949 with Nappy La Marre and the Dixie Land Bobcats, and continues to this day as the Lobero Theatre was named one of *Downbeat* magazine's Best Jazz Venues, worldwide.

More recently, we've played host to modern giants like John Cleese, Tracy Chapman, Jeff Bridges,

Bobby McFerrin, Mikhail Baryshnikov, Neil Young, and Lindsey Buckingham. We are also the home stage to many of the major performing arts groups in Santa Barbara including State Street Ballet, Sings Like Hell, Santa Barbara International Film Festival, CAMA's Masterseries, Santa Barbara Youth Symphony, Flamenco Arts Festival and Music Academy of the West.

Today, the theatre is managed by the Lobero Theatre Foundation. They work to maintain, improve and operate the historic Lobero Theatre as a performing arts center and cultural asset to the community, and to present the highest quality productions in music, dance and theatre.

The Lobero Theatre is California's only historic performing arts venue that is Green Business Certified. From reusable pint cups to a robust recycling and composting program, we are continually working on ways to reduce the theater's carbon footprint and create a sustainable business model for the future.

Waste Reduction:

- We compost! Please look for the specially marked bins throughout the venue to separate trash.
- All single-use cups, plates, and utensils provided at the Lobero are compostable.
- Concession systems utilize beer and wine keg systems instead of bottles and cans.
- If you are planning a reception, we will supply compostable cups, plates and flatware.
- Talk to our reception coordinator to learn more about these programs.

BYO Bottle:

- We have eliminated single use plastic water bottles on the property.
- Please make use of the dishes and complimentary water bottles in the artist greenroom and backstage areas.
- Patrons are welcome to bring their own reusable bottles and pint cups and fill them at water stations.
- We provide complimentary water for each performance.

LED Stage & Auditorium Lighting:

The Lobero's entire stage lighting system composed of energy-efficient LED's.

Water Wise:

 The Lobero has drought tolerant plants and low-flow plumbing fixtures throughout the property.


