Lobero LIVE presents Shawn Colvin and Her Band A Few Small Repairs 20th Anniversary Tour With Special Guests Larry Campbell and Teresa Williams

Sunday, October 8 at 7 PM at the Lobero Theatre

Santa Barbara, CA, September 19, 2017 – Lobero LIVE is delighted to welcome Shawn Colvin back to the Lobero on October 8 to celebrate the 20th Anniversary of her GRAMMY® winning album, A Few Small Repairs. In an era when female singer-songwriters are ever more ubiquitous, Shawn Colvin stands out as a singular and enduring talent. Her songs are slow-release works of craft and catharsis that become treasured, lifetime companions for their listeners. Colvin will embark the A Few Small Repairs 20th Anniversary Tour this fall—her first major tour with a full band since the album's original release. This tour will showcase Shawn performing the album in its entirety alongside a variety of hits, personal favorites and surprises from her repertoire. Multi-instrumentalist-singer Larry Campbell & his wife singer-guitarist Teresa Williams will support all dates in addition to appearing in the band.

By the time that *A Few Small Repairs* and "Sunny Came Home" catapulted her into the pop mainstream, Shawn Colvin was already a well-established recording artist and touring performer with a resume of accolades. Her 1989 John-Leventhal-produced debut, *Steady On*, had taken home the GRAMMY® for Best Contemporary Folk Album and subsequent releases *Fat City* (1992) and *Cover Girl* (1994) each multiple-categories nominees. *A Few Small Repairs* includes the GRAMMY® Award-winning "Sunny Came Home" plus chart-toppers "You and The Mona Lisa" and "Nothin' On Me", and saw Colvin foray into third-person storytelling with a powerful impact. Drawing from the downs and ups of her own life experiences, Shawn Colvin crafted an album of emotional complexity, nuance and revelation, combining images of traditional femininity and domesticity—wedding gowns, kitchens, white picket fences—with images of tools as metaphors for reparation.

The 20th Anniversary Edition of <u>A Few Small Repairs</u> will feature the original album remastered with seven bonus audio tracks and seven rare live performances culled from the Sony Music archives, plus enhanced artwork including newly-written liner notes by Shawn Colvin and producer John Leventhal and recently discovered archival photos.

Larry Campbell and Teresa Williams

Multi-instrumentalist-singer Larry Campbell & singer-guitarist Teresa Williams have long provided musical firepower for artists such as Levon Helm, Bob Dylan, Mavis Staples, Little Feat, Phil Lesh and Friends, Rosanne Cash and Hot Tuna. When the duo stepped onto center stage in 2015 with their eponymous Red House Records

debut, Larry Campbell & Teresa Williams, the response was immediate: the release placed them atop the Americana Radio charts. Mojo called them "The first couple of Americana," while Uncut gave the album 9/10 stars describing it as "Passionate, eloquent, spilling over with regal harmonies...channeling Emmylou and Gram." Numerous festival and theater appearances and a national tour opening for and performing with Jackson Browne followed as Larry & Teresa built a devoted following.
