Blending ethereal harmonies and intricate musicianship with a uniquely powerful brand of contemporary songcraft, The Milk Carton Kids are a major force in the American folk tradition. With their intricately twinned acoustic guitars and deadpan banter, Kenneth Pattengale and Joey Ryan - the clown princes of Americana music - are the Smothers Brothers for a new generation. Defying the conventions of melody and harmony is a strategy that the GRAMMY® Award nominated band has consciously embraced. The group's new record, *The Only Ones*, finds Ryan and Pattengale performing a stripped-down acoustic set without a backing band, returning to the core of what they are about musically: the duo. Their latest album continues to receive extensive praise, with *Rolling Stone* proclaiming that “Kenneth Pattengale and Joey Ryan get back to the beautiful basics with *The Only Ones*.”

Through soft acoustic guitar picking and deftly accented trombone sighs, Hayley Heynderickx's music immediately recalls folk music of the '60s and '70s mixed with a love of jazz radio. But her singing, with vocals that range from sultry to operatic, belie a tenacity in her soul. Her debut album, named *I Need to Start a Garden* out of a search for calm through these waves of uncertainty and upheaval, is out now via Mama Bird Recording Co. Heynderickx vacillates between powerlessness and empowerment. It's a balance between exposing and protecting herself, but her generosity of spirit remains the constant throughout the whole album.
