James Lefevre Studios presents
the World Premiere of
Amateur Skaters
at the Lobero Theatre
Friday, October 22, 2021 at 7 PM

Santa Barbara, CA, October 4, 2021 – James Lefevre Studios presents the world premiere of Amateur Skaters, Friday, October 22, 2021 at 7 PM. The feature-length documentary, directed by one of the youngest filmmakers of the century at age fourteen, was shot on location in Santa Barbara County. Taking inspiration from films like We Are Blood (2015), Lefevre explores the world of skateboarding through the lens of four young skaters.

"When I saw how important skating is to so many people in the age range that *Amateur Skaters* focuses on, I felt a need to document from when they first started skating as 'amateurs', deepening their understanding and skill of skateboarding, building perseverance and self-confidence on their journey to becoming pro," says director Shemsu J. Lefevre. His goal is to bring positive awareness to the sport with this film by releasing to a wider audience than is standard for this type of documentary.

The film features local skaters Kai Tautrim, Rowan Brownlee, Kahlil Aguilar, and Isaac Relis, along with appearances by professional skateboarders, such as Andy Anderson. Pushing themselves to be the best they can, they endure many physical and emotional obstacles and grow as both skaters and people. The premiere will be streamed live online, followed by a series of three online events held during the week after the event, including Q&As with the cast and director, panel discussions, and commentaries.

Tickets for <u>Amateur Skaters</u> are on sale now at <u>Lobero.org</u> and at the <u>Lobero Box Office 805.963.0761</u>. General Admission is \$30, Youth 17 and under is \$10. Ticket prices include a per ticket Lobero <u>Facility Fee</u>; other <u>fees</u> may also apply.
