Santa Barbara, CA, November 1, 2021 – Lobero LIVE presents **Gregory Alan Isakov w/ Special Guest Israel Nebeker (of Blind Pilot), Friday and Saturday, November 26 & 27, 2021 at 8 PM.** With deep lyrical masterpieces that tell a story of miles and landscapes, and the search for a sense of place, the GRAMMY® nominated troubadour has cast an impressive presence on the indie-folk music scene. The evening will also feature special guest Israel Nebeker, whose greatest successes have come through his role as songwriter/band leader/producer of Blind Pilot.

Isakov tours internationally with his band, and has performed with several national symphony orchestras across the United States. His five full-length studio albums include *That Sea*, *The Gambler*, *This Empty Northern Hemisphere*, *The Weatherman*, *Gregory Alan Isakov with the Colorado Symphony*, and *Evening Machines* (nominated for a GRAMMY® Award for Best Folk Album). Born in Johannesburg, South Africa, and now calling Colorado home, the artist has become widely known these past few years not just for his noteworthy work as a musician, but his deep passion for horticulture, often using gardening and sustainable farming to keep him grounded when he isn't on tour. In addition to owning his independent record label, Suitcase Town Music, he also manages a small farm in Boulder County, which provides produce to the farm's CSA members and to local restaurants.

Israel Nebeker is a songwriter from the Oregon Coast, whose intricate folk-driven songs create an intimate space akin to the rainy, wild, sandy landscapes of his home and to the people whose stories belong to it. His songs connect to a worldwide audience through his singing of the profoundly personal. Nebeker's strong lyricism and colorful melodies have been at the center of the critically acclaimed band and the albums they have recorded. He has appeared on *NPR's Morning Edition*, *World Cafe*, *Late Night with David Letterman*, and *The Ellen Degeneres Show*.
