Deep flavors of his Louisiana bayou home nourish his heartfelt, impeccably crafted songs. Marc released multiple albums with major labels over the years, but has recently returned to his independent roots, which allows him to release more content and truly tap into his creative spirit.

His work has always been about tying his music to a mission, and making the world a better place is a mantra that he has been bound to since the beginning of his career. "Philanthropy has been a big part of my life for a long time," he says. "I've found that artists like me are uniquely positioned to raise awareness and make a difference in our own communities and beyond. In 2015, I decided to make philanthropy a more permanent part of my life by establishing the SOS Foundation. The goal is to use music, both recorded and live, to raise money for causes I'm passionate about."

Jamie McLean Band is a triple threat. The group's energetic and captivating live show is undeniable. McLean's fiery guitar and top line songwriting chops have crafted profound, honest, and heartfelt songs. From Madison

The band's latest album, *Paradise Found*, was produced by Ken Coomer of Wilco at Nashville's studio and features the band's strongest and most mainstream songwriting to date.
