Santa Barbara, CA, November 30, 2021 – An Evening with Pete Souza: Two Presidents, One Photographer comes to the Lobero Theatre on January 22, 2022 at 8 PM. As the Chief Official White House Photographer for President Barack Obama and Official White House Photographer for President Reagan from 1983-1989, Pete was in a unique position to spend rare and intimate moments in the Oval Office observing two transformative Presidents of the United States. He shares some of his iconic behind-the-scenes photographs, along with his poignant detailed stories, all leading to a bold and dynamic depiction of true leadership. Join best-selling author, speaker and freelance photographer Pete Souza as he showcases the stories behind fifty-six of his favorite photographs of President Reagan and Obama. Hear his insight behind the captured moments showing the two President's humanity and respect for the office they held and the people with whom they interacted. Pete's book, "Obama: An Intimate Portrait," debuted at #1 on *The New York Times* best-sellers list and is one of the best-selling photography books of all time. Souza has also worked as a freelancer for *National Geographic*, an Official White House Photographer for President Reagan, the national photographer for the *Chicago Tribune*, and as an assistant professor at Ohio University's School of Visual Communication. Along with his Tribune colleagues, he shared in receiving the Pulitzer Prize in 2001 for explanatory journalism.

After 9/11, Souza was among the first journalists to cover the fall of Kabul, Afghanistan, after crossing the Hindu Kush mountains by horseback in three feet of snow. He has had solo exhibits of his work throughout the country, and he has given presentations of his photography at venues such as Carnegie Hall, the Smithsonian Museum of African American History and Culture, and the Tate Modern in London. Souza has won numerous awards including several times in the prestigious Pictures of the Year annual competition, the NPPA's Best of Photojournalism, and the White House News Photographers Association's yearly contest.

Souza became the subject of a documentary film in November 2020, *The Way I See It*. Directed by Dawn Porter and produced by Porter, Laura Dern, Jayme Lemons, and Evan Hayes, the film takes an unprecedented look behind the scenes of two of the most iconic Presidents in history – Reagan and Obama – as seen through Souza's eyes and camera. The film reveals how Souza transformed from a respected White House photographer and photojournalist to a searing commentator on the importance of having someone with dignity and empathy in the office of the Presidency. *The Way I See It* was named Best Documentary by the New York Film Critics and was the winner of the Critics' Choice Award for Most Compelling Living Subject of a Documentary.
