Santa Barbara, CA, August 1, 2022 – Lobero LIVE presents **Tab Benoit with special guest JD Simo on Friday, September 2, 2022 at 7:30 PM**. Benoit is a GRAMMY® nominated singer, songwriter, and guitarist who has built a remarkable 30+ year career on the foundation of his gritty, soulful Delta swamp blues. The artist has received 5 Blues Music Awards, including BB King Entertainer of the Year (twice) and an induction into The Louisiana Music Hall of Fame. Nashville-based singer, songwriter, guitarist, and producer JD Simo opens the show.

One of the most impressive guitarists to emerge from the rich Bayous of Southern Louisiana in recent years, Tab Benoit's guitar tone can be recognized before his Otis-Redding-ish voice resonates from the speakers. He doesn't rely on any effects and his set up is simple. It consists of a guitar, cord, and Category 5 Amplifier. The effects that you hear come from his fingers. The artist has recorded and/or performed with Junior Wells, George Porter Jr, Dr. John, Willie Nelson, Big Chief Monk Boudreaux, Billy Joe Shaver, Maria Muldaur, and numerous others. His accomplishments as a musician are matched only by his devotion to the environmental health of his native Louisiana wetlands as founder and driving force behind Voice of the Wetlands.

JD Simo connects the missing link between Motown and Woodstock, as he fuses fluid and fiery fretwork with vital and vulnerable vocals. The artist has been acclaimed by *Rolling Stone*, *NPR*, *Guitar Player*, *Relix*, *No Depression*, and more. Logging hundreds of gigs annually, JD has collaborated with Jack White, Tommy Emmanuel, Luther Dickinson, and Blackberry Smoke among others. He has graced the bills of numerous festivals, including Bonnaroo, Warren Haynes Christmas Jam, and Mountain Jam. In addition, Phil Lesh, iconic co-founder of The Grateful Dead, invited him to join Phil Lesh and Friends. Simo's latest album, *Mind Control*, released in 2021, is JD's most unique, original and rawest effort to date.
