Santa Barbara, CA, November 1, 2022 – JAZZ AT THE BALLROOM (JATB) comes to Lobero Theatre in Santa Barbara to present *Holiday "In"* – a hip twist on classic holiday tunes on **Friday**, **December 2 at 7 PM**.

Award-winning musicians from across the country take turns on stage for a show reminiscent of the old Christmas specials with Bing Crosby, Frank Sinatra, and other singing greats. The evening is a tip-of-the hat to Crosby's classic film, *Holiday Inn*, and the past two years — when there was no place BUT home for the holidays.

Host and comedian, **Dan Cronin**, (longtime writer for *Conan O'Brien*) shares the stage with bandleader **Konrad Paszkduzki** on piano, as well as **Niki Haris** ("The Big Voice" behind Madonna), **Adrian Cunningham** (Australia's "Down Under Sax Star"), **Champian Fulton**, (Birdland, Ronnie Scotts London), **Alphonso Horne** (Jazz at Lincoln Center, Late Show with Jon Batiste), and LA's young, hip Lineage Trio (from bands of Seth McFarlane, Michael Bublé, Jeff Goldblum). JAZZ AT THE BALLROOM is a Bay Area-based nonprofit committed to keeping swinging, classic jazz thriving, sharing the American Songbook with the greater public, and providing audiences with one-of-a-kind performances. Beyond their concerts, the organization works to introduce, teach, and explore this American art form through workshops, public events, and performances at schools, hospitals, and senior living communities. Through these efforts, they keep the unforgettable music alive in the community and foster a love of music in future generations.

DAN CRONIN has been a featured stand-up and performer on NBC's *Late Night with Conan O'Brien* as well as Comedy Central's *Premium Blend*. He won an Emmy Award and most recently, a Writer's Guild Award, for his work as a longtime staff writer for both *Late Night* and *Conan* on TBS. You can also hear him as a recurring character, Terry Melon, in the Southern California-set cult favorite podcast, *Valley Heat*.

KONRAD PASZKUDZKI, the concert's pianist and bandleader, serves as Artistic Director of JATB. Originally from Perth, Australia, Konrad came to the U.S. for grad school at Miami's Frost School of Music and moved to New York to lead the house trio at 54 Below. In 2013, Konrad joined the John Pizzarelli Quartet. His 1000+ performances include such venues as New York's Café Carlyle, Bemelmans, Birdland, and Dizzy's, DC's Blues Alley, Montreal Jazz Festival, and LA's Walt Disney Concert Hall.
