Santa Barbara, CA, February 14, 2023 – Jazz at the Lobero Ovation Series presents **Preservation Hall Jazz Band, in association with AMP Worldwide and Belly Up Entertainment, on Friday, March 3, 2023 at 7:30 PM.** From the heart of the French Quarter to the world's stage, Preservation Hall Jazz Band has spread the joyful, timeless spirit of true New Orleans jazz since 1961. Preservation Hall is a humble, much-loved room dedicated to keeping the past and future of jazz alive. People from around the globe make pilgrimages to it, and now Preservation Hall Jazz Band is embarking on a pilgrimage of its own. Their nationwide tour, *Pass It On – 60th Anniversary Musical Celebration*, commemorates six decades of the Hall's well-worn, well-loved space that's physically small, but spiritually huge.

This legendary ensemble was formed by Allan Jaffe, who bought the building with his wife, Sandra, and aptly named it Preservation Hall. The band has toured with singer Josh Groban, and has shared the stage with numerous renowned musicians such as Stevie Wonder, Elvis Costello, The Grateful Dead, and countless others. Today, the band is led by Allan's son, Ben Jaffe. Their mission remains focused on initiating audiences into the ineffable, almost religious experience of channeling their ancestors through the music and culture they've inherited from them. Band members include Branden Lewis (trumpet), Clint Maedgen (saxophone), Kerry Lewis (bass), Kyle Roussel (piano), Revon Andrews (trombone), and Glen Andrews (drums).

While traditional New Orleans jazz repertoire remains their core focus, they've transformed into a vibrantly cross-pollinated ambassador for New Orleans – exploring original compositions, Afro-Cuban rhythms, R&B influences, and collaborating with artists beyond the jazz spectrum. Preservation Hall Jazz Band has featured a long cadre of legendary musicians over the years and issued a number of albums, all of which showcase the group's rootsy, soulful brand of traditional New Orleans jazz.
