Santa Barbara, CA, March 15, 2023 – In honor of the Lobero Theatre’s 150th anniversary, Lobero LIVE presents **An Evening with Colin Hay, with special guest Lazlo Bane, on Wednesday, April 5, 2023, at 7:30 PM**. Writing, recording, and touring extensively throughout the world as a solo artist, singer-songwriter Colin Hay is beloved for his intimate, confessional live shows. The artist has had a prolific career, both as the lead singer and principal songwriter for the GRAMMY® Award-winning, multi-platinum selling band Men At Work, and a solo career that spans 25 years and 15 albums. This show will feature songs from his entire catalog, including latest releases “Now and the Evermore” and “I Just Don’t Know What to do With Myself,” engaging stories he is known for, and special rare accompaniment by his acoustic band.

The range of artists who have chosen to cite him as a muse or who have recently found themselves on stage with him spans the genre landscape from heavy metal, to Americana, Cuban rhythms, and beyond. His inclusion as a playlist favorite from the likes of Metallica to the Lumineers reflects his continuing relevance and broad appeal. Since 2019, he has also toured and played under the Men At Work banner with his LA based group of musicians, where he plays an exclusively Men At Work set. He is also presently part of Ringo Starr’s All Starr Band.

Lazlo Bane is an American alt-rock band formed in Los Angeles in 1995 by Chad Fischer (vocals, guitar, piano), featuring Chris Link (vocals, bass, banjo), Tim Bright (vocals, guitar), and Robert Burke aka Chicken (vocals, drums). The group has been recording, touring, and making videos together for 25 years. Their first LP, *11 Transistor*, released by Almo Sounds/Geffen in 1996, included a cover of Men At Work’s “Overkill” and featured Colin Hay as a guest vocal. The video for the song went on to become a top 10 for MTV2 the following year and marked the first of several collaborations with Colin Hay. Over the years, the band has composed a number of songs for films and TV series.
