Good Medicine and Numbskull present

Asleep At The Wheel

Thursday, June 8, 2023 at 7:30 PM

Santa Barbara, CA, May 17, 2023 – Good Medicine and Numbskull present Asleep At The Wheel on Thursday, June 8, 2023 at 7:30 PM. Asleep at the Wheel has been part of the American Roots music landscape for more than 50 years. Inspired by Western Swing and Honky-Tonk Country, the group has accrued 20 GRAMMY® Awards, released over twenty albums, and has charted more than 21 singles on the Billboard country charts. Although the lineup has changed countless times since its inception, frontman Ray Benson has held it together since 1970, traversing the globe as an ambassador of Western Swing music and introducing its irresistible sound to generation after generation. That far-reaching appeal remains a testament to Benson's initial vision of forming a band to bring the roots of American pop music into the present.

Even though the band got its start on a farm in Paw Paw, West Virginia, they became a cornerstone of the Austin, Texas scene upon their arrival in 1973. Throughout their lengthy career, they have not simply preserved classic sounds, but have earned critical praise updating the music and keeping the art form alive. The group celebrated their 50th anniversary with the release of 2021's *Half a Hundred Years*, an album that included guest appearances from friends and fans Willie Nelson, George Strait, Emmylou Harris, and Lyle Lovett, as well as contributions from three members from the original lineup, Chris O'Connell, Lucky Oceans, and Leroy Preston. Produced by Ray Benson and manager Sam Seifert, this is the band's 26th studio album, and was released by Home Records, a sublabel of Bismeaux Productions, with Thirty Tigers.
