Roger Clyne and The Peacemakers and Dave Hause & The Mermaid

Santa Barbara, CA, August 22, 2023 – Lobero LIVE presents **Roger Clyne and The Peacemakers and Dave Hause & The Mermaid on Sunday, September 24, 2023 at 7 PM**. Roger Clyne and The Peacemakers features Roger (lead vocals, guitar), P.H. Naffah (drums), Nick Scropos (bass), and Jim Dalton (lead guitar). The band, which emerged in 1999 as a Southwestern supergroup, specializes in literate, pop-tinged Americana. Over the years, they have toured across the US and achieved a faithful following through hard work and great music. Dave Hause & The Mermaid, featuring Dave (vocals and guitar), Tim Hause (lead guitar), Miles Bentley (bass), Kevin Conroy (drums), and Kayleigh Goldsworthy (keyboard), combines Americana tones and socially driven lyrics with punk spirit. Dave's latest release, co-written with his younger brother Tim, is the distinct next phase of their creative partnership.

Roger Clyne & The Peacemakers' unique blend of punk rock, country-western, and mariachi influences have made the group one of America's best live rock-n-roll bands. In 2019, they were inducted into the Arizona Music and Entertainment Hall of Fame, joining the likes of fellow Arizona legends Alice Cooper, Buck Owens, Glen Campbell, Stevie Nicks, Linda Ronstadt and Waylon Jennings. Later that fall, the band headlined Sammy Hagar's Cabo Wabo Cantina on the eve of Hagar's weekend birthday celebration. They also curate their own annual music festival, Circus Mexicus, in the sleepy beach town of Puerto Peñasco, Mexico, which draws thousands of fans from around the world, and host charity events to raise money for a local orphanage, support local youth sports, and help feed shelter animals. Today, as Clyne prepares to record his 11th studio album, he continues to transform his life experiences, inspirations, observations and his own muses into timeless music.

Since releasing his debut album, *Resolutions*, in 2011, Philadelphia-born songwriter **Dave Hause** has poured his whole heart, soul, and life into his music. The artist, who records in Goleta and has called Santa Barbara home for nearly a decade, loves the area and performed a benefit concert at Cold Spring Tavern a bit back after the fires in 2018. His sixth full-length, *Drive It Like It's Stolen*, overflows with Hause's trademark urgency and passion, shimmering with a truth that reflects the harsh realities of life in this day and age, as well the intermittent jolts of joy that punctuate it. After all, his songs have always detailed his own personal traumas and triumphs within the setting of an unforgiving capitalist backdrop, tethering those personal experiences to ineluctable external forces. His latest release is just as earnest and heartfelt, raw and real as anything he's ever written before. However, there's also a subtle yet significant difference – here he's delving into a more fictional type of storytelling to create what he terms "post-apocalyptic Americana." The third release on the brothers' own Blood Harmony record label, it shakes up expectations, while at the same time building off the sound and reputation Hause has established for himself over the past decade or so.
