Santa Barbara, CA, October 18, 2023 – Lobero LIVE presents **Bruce Cockburn, with special guest Steve Postell on Saturday, November 18, 2023 at 7:30 PM**. For 50 years, Canadian musical legend Bruce Cockburn has been capturing in song the essence of human experience – while fiercely striving to make it better. The artist has enjoyed an illustrious career shaped by politics, spirituality, and musical diversity. His remarkable journey has seen him embrace folk, jazz, rock, and worldbeat styles while travelling to such far-flung places as Guatemala, Mali, Mozambique, and Nepal – writing memorable songs about his ever-expanding world of wonders. His commitment to growth has made Bruce Cockburn both an exemplary citizen and a legendary artist, whose prized songbook will be celebrated for many years to come.

Cockburn has earned high praise as an exceptional songwriter and a revered guitarist. His guitar playing, both acoustic and electric, has placed him in the company of the world's top instrumentalists. For his many achievements, the Ottawa-born artist has been honoured with 13 Juno Awards, an induction into both the Canadian Music Hall of Fame and the Canadian Songwriters Hall of Fame, as well as the Governor General's Performing Arts Award, and has been made an Officer of the Order of Canada. His latest release, *O sun O Moon*, a contemplative effort divided between personal and political themes, is the #1 most added album on Americana radio. As the universal accolades and extensive airplay continue to pour in for the 78-year-old's 38th album, True North Records recently released a new single, "Us All," along with a string of additional world tour dates.

Steve Postell is a seasoned touring and session player who has collaborated with some of the finest musicians in the world, such as David Crosby, Jennifer Warnes, Michael McDonald, John Oates, Robben Ford, and numerous others. Trained at The Mannes College of Music in New York City, Steve has had a successful, prolific career which spans his days playing with Pure Prairie League and performing on Broadway. He has amassed a legacy of musical contributions and released several solo records, including the critically acclaimed *Time Still Knockin'* on Immurgent Records. An acclaimed singer-songwriter, composer and producer, Steve is also a member of band The Immediate Family.
