Poncho Sanchez and His Latin Jazz Band

Friday, June 28, 2024 at 7:30 PM

Santa Barbara, CA, May 30, 2024 – Jazz at the Lobero presents **Poncho Sanchez and His Latin Jazz Band on Friday, June 28, 2024 at 7:30 PM**. GRAMMY® Award-winner Poncho Sanchez is among the most influential percussionists in jazz. For more than four decades, he's stirred up a fiery stew of straightahead jazz, gritty soul music, and infectious melodies and rhythms from a variety of Latin American and South American sources. Band members include Poncho Sanchez (Band Leader/congas), Francisco Torres (Musical Director/trombone), Ron Blake (trumpet), Giancarlo Anderson (bongos), Andy Langham (piano), Tom Luer (saxophone), Jose Perez (timbales), Ross Schodek (bass), and James Aparicio (sound man).

Although born in Laredo, Texas, in 1951 to a large Mexican-American family, Sanchez grew up in a suburb of Los Angeles, where he was raised on an unusual cross section of sounds that included straightahead jazz, Latin Jazz and American soul. By his teen years, his musical consciousness had been solidified by the likes of John Coltrane, Miles Davis, Cal Tjader, Mongo Santamaria, Wilson Pickett, and James Brown. Along the way, he taught himself to play guitar, flute, drums and timbales, but eventually settled on the congas. Throughout his career, the conguero has held aloft the torch lit by such innovators as Mongo Santamaria, Tito Puente and Cal Tjader, embraced by each of those icons and entrusted to carry forward the traditions of Latin jazz.

With his most recent album *Trane's Delight*, Sanchez continues to honor the giants whose music has helped shape his own, while building upon the rich legacy they've left behind. As this celebratory and heartfelt album exemplifies, he's long since joined the ranks of the luminaries to whom he pays such profound tribute. Sanchez's deeply personal reimagining of the jazz canon, as well as his own spirited original compositions, affirm his place at the forefront of Latin Jazz's trailblazers.
