Santa Barbara, CA, October 21, 2024 – EARL MINNIS PRESENTS and Lobero Theatre Foundation present **John Hiatt on Tuesday, November 12, 2024 at 7:30 PM**. A master lyricist and satirical storyteller, John Hiatt delivers songs filled with tales of redemption, relationships and surrendering on his own terms. Widely regarded as one of the finest songwriters of his generation, Hiatt earned respect from critics and fellow artists long before he reached a broader audience. His music, which has graced more than 20 studio albums, earned him a place in the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame, a BMI Troubadour Award, and a Lifetime Achievement in songwriting designation from the Americana Music Association.

Hiatt's songs have been recorded by everyone from Bob Dylan, Emmylou Harris, and B.B. King, to Willie Nelson, Bonnie Raitt and scores of others. His extensive body of work explores folk, rock, pop, R&B, country, and blues with equal enthusiasm. While the artist's lyrics can shift seamlessly from sharp sarcasm to deep introspection, his powerful, captivating melodies reinvent rock and blues conventions into something new. Hiatt's finest album is 1987's *Bring the Family*; other catalog highlights include the pop and rock of 1983's *Riding with the King*, the rough-hewn blues-rock of 2008's *Same Old Man*, and 2021's *Leftover Feelings*, a collaboration with dobro virtuoso Jerry Douglas.
