## Spotlight on Jazz at the Lobero

For nearly a decade, the Lobero Theatre has honored jazz legend Dave Brubeck through its **Jazz at the Lobero** programming — curating diverse, world-class performances on our historic stage. Over time, this commitment has grown into **The Brubeck Circle**, a tiered membership program that plays a vital role in supporting our youth education initiatives.

Brubeck Circle contributions directly sustain the **Santa Barbara Vocal Jazz Foundation**, which brings jazz history and appreciation to local elementary schools through live, in-class performances, and ultimately, an on-stage performance open to the public. Under the same umbrella, the **Brubeck Jazz Residency with The Derek Douget Band** provides an enriching week-long program that offers hands-on

mentorship to students at the junior high, high school, and college levels.

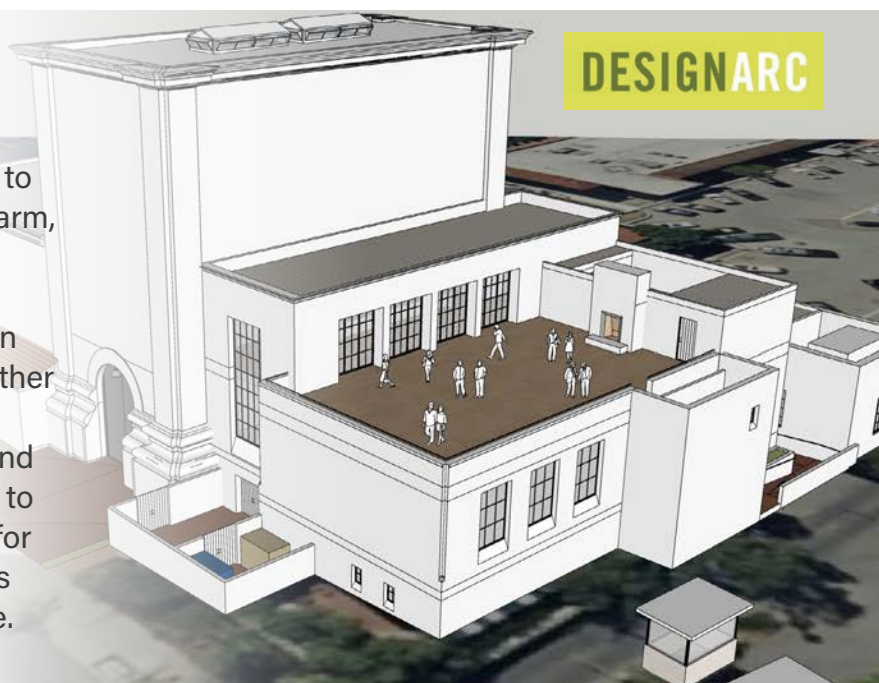

## Inspiring the Next Generation

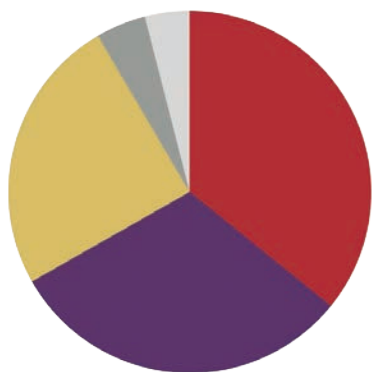

In addition, the programs also offer subsidized tickets to low-income children, families, and seniors to attend performances throughout the year.

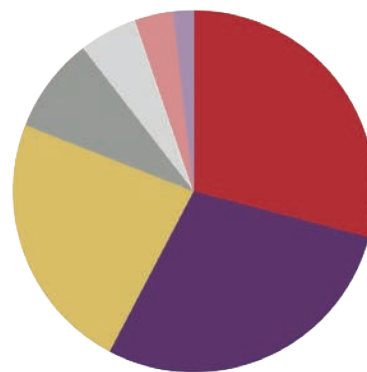
The 2024–25 season marked, in many ways, a return to normalcy. After celebrating two milestone anniversaries in 2023 and 2024, the Lobero Board and Staff refocused on the day-to-day work of our mission: maintaining and operating the historic Lobero Theatre as a community asset and presenting exceptional performing arts for our audiences.

### Maintaining the historic Lobero Theatre

Just because it's historic doesn't mean it shouldn't be technologically advanced. In the past two years we have completely replaced our lighting and sound systems, upgrades that we hope you have been enjoying as much as the artists who perform on our stage.

### Operating the theater as a community asset

Our partnership with local performing arts organizations has never been stronger. Opera Santa Barbara, State Street Ballet, CAMA, Music Academy of the West, Santa Barbara Revels, Prime Time Band, the Spirit of Fiesta Committee, Flamenco Arts Festival, Santa Barbara Youth Symphony, Momentum Dance and Santa Barbara Flyfishers all make their annual home at the Lobero. They receive priority access to our calendar — before outside promoters — as well as subsidies that help keep rental costs manageable. The Lobero truly serves as Santa Barbara's community stage, a welcoming home for local arts.
