## **Don McLean**

**Friday, February 6, 2026 at 7:30 PM**

*Santa Barbara, CA, January 52, 2026* – Earl Minnis Presents and Lobero Theatre Foundation present **Don McLean on Friday, February 6, 2026 at 7:30 PM**. The legendary singer-songwriter emerged from the '60s folk revival as a gifted troubadour whose early years were shaped by a deep love of music, intimate coffeehouse performances, and a commitment to storytelling rooted in the American experience. His appearance at the Lobero promises an intimate evening with a true original, celebrating the songs that have shaped popular music and continue to move audiences worldwide.

McLean's 1970 debut album *Tapestry* established him as a rising voice on FM radio and laid the foundation for a career defined by poetic songwriting and unforgettable melodies, with songs such as "And I Love You So" and "Castles in the Air." The artist then achieved international superstardom in 1971 with the release of *American Pie*, the landmark album that included the iconic eight-minute title track — now recognized as one of the greatest songs of the 20th century — as well as "Vincent (Starry, Starry Night)." *American Pie* topped charts around the world, made McLean a global concert attraction, and cemented his reputation as a master interpreter of both original material and classic American songs.

McLean has released more than 20 studio albums since his debut. Over the decades, his work has been recorded by artists ranging from Madonna, Garth Brooks, and Drake to Josh Groban and Weird Al Yankovic, while his songs have remained cultural touchstones across generations. Throughout a career spanning more than six decades, McLean has received countless honors, including induction into the Songwriters Hall of Fame, the GRAMMY® Hall of Fame, the Library of Congress' National Recording Registry, and a Lifetime Achievement Award from BBC Radio 2. He continues to tour and record, sharing a body of work that blends folk, pop, and rock with rare emotional resonance.
