For more than three decades, Colvin has captivated audiences with her eloquent songwriting, luminous voice, and deeply personal storytelling. A celebrated artist whose career spans thirteen acclaimed albums, a best-selling memoir, and countless performances around the world, Colvin continues to inspire generations of music lovers while touring internationally and working on new music. Her remarkable career has been recognized with the Americana Music Association's Lifetime Achievement Trailblazer Award and induction into the Austin City Limits Hall of Fame alongside legendary artists Lyle Lovett and Buddy Guy.

One of America's most respected singer-songwriters, Colvin has built a legacy defined by artistry, honesty, and emotional depth. Her debut album, *Steady On*, earned the GRAMMY® Award for Best Contemporary Folk Recording, launching a career that reached new heights with the platinum-selling *A Few Small Repairs* and its iconic hit, "Sunny Came Home." The song garnered two of music's highest honors—GRAMMY® Awards for Record of the Year and Song of the Year—and established Colvin as one of the most distinctive voices in contemporary folk and Americana. Throughout her career, she has continued to earn critical acclaim for albums including *These Four Walls* and *Shawn Colvin Live*, while her intimate performances remain beloved for their warmth, wit, and emotional resonance.

Shawn has maintained a non-stop national and international touring schedule, appeared on countless television and radio programs, had her songs featured in major motion pictures, and created a remarkable canon of work. Today, she remains a singular presence in American music, creating songs that blend poetic craftsmanship with heartfelt storytelling and unforgettable melodies. Audiences can expect an intimate evening with one of the finest songwriters of her generation, as Colvin shares timeless favorites alongside stories and songs that continue to define an extraordinary career.
