Santa Barbara, CA, August 12, 2026 EARL MINNIS PRESENTS and the Lobero Theatre Foundation present **Songs and Stories with Roger McGuinn on Saturday, September 12, 2026 at 7:30 PM.** Rock & Roll Hall of Famer Roger McGuinn brings six decades of music, memories, and songcraft to the Lobero stage. Best known for helping pioneer folk-rock with The Byrds, McGuinn transformed the sound of popular music with his signature chiming 12-string Rickenbacker, creating an enduring musical language that would influence generations of artists. From “Mr. Tambourine Man” and “Turn! Turn! Turn!” to “Eight Miles High” and “Chestnut Mare,” his work remains woven into the fabric of American music.

McGuinn offers an intimate evening that goes beyond the hits, blending iconic Byrds songs, traditional folk music, solo favorites, and stories from a remarkable life in music. With his distinctive tenor and wry humor, the artist brings audiences inside the songs—sharing the history, influences, techniques, and personal experiences behind them. Drawing from folk, country, blues, rock, and even Indian classical music, his performances reveal the musical crossroads that helped shape his singular sound. His long-running Folk Den project further reflects his commitment to preserving traditional American songs while giving them new life for contemporary audiences.

A pioneer, innovator, and consummate storyteller, McGuinn continues to connect generations through music that feels both timeless and immediate. His influence can be heard in artists ranging from Tom Petty and R.E.M. to countless Americana, folk, and alternative musicians who continue to chase the shimmering “jingle-jangle” sound he helped define. Songs and Stories with Roger McGuinn promises an unforgettable evening of music and memories from one of American music’s true originals.
